

# Painting Degree Pathway

New students are advised to enrol to one unit in the first instance, and this should be the first core unit.



## Level 1 (HE4)

120 credits required = 3x 40 credit units

1. Drawing 1: Drawing skills (core)

2. Painting 1: Practice of painting (core)

3. Painting 1: Understanding painting media (core)

## Level 2 (HE5)

120 credits required = 2x 60 credit units

Painting 2: Studio practice (core)

Select one (elective)

- Drawing 2: Investigating drawing
- Painting 2: Exploring media

## Level 3 (HE6)

120 credits required = 3x 40 credit units

1. Units studied concurrently (core)

- Painting 3: Major project
- Painting 3: Contextual studies

2. Painting 3: Sustaining your practice (core)
