

# Fine Art Degree Pathway



New students are advised to enrol to one unit in the first instance, and we would advise students complete the elective units first

## Level 1 (HE4)

120 credits required = 3x 40 credit units

### 1 & 2. Elective (Select two)

- Painting 1: Understanding painting media
- Drawing 1: Exploring drawing media
- Sculpture 1: Starting out in 3D
- Printmaking 1: Introduction to printmaking

### 3. Visual Studies 1: Understanding visual culture (core)

## Level 2 (HE5)

120 credits required = 2x 60 credit units

### Elective (Select two)

- Painting 2: Studio practice  
*(prerequisite Painting 1/Drawing 1/Sculpture 1)*
- Drawing 2: Investigating drawing
- Sculpture 2: Studio practice  
*(prerequisite Sculpture 1)*
- Printmaking 2: Developing your style  
*(prerequisite Printmaking 1)*
- Visual Studies 2: Understanding Visual Culture
- Drawing 2: Personal approach to drawing

## Level 3 (HE6)

120 credits required = 3x 40 credit units

### 1. Units studied concurrently (core)

- Fine Art 3: Advanced Practice
- Fine Art 3: Research

### 2. \*Fine Art 3: Sustaining your practice (core)

Level 3 units of the Fine Art Degree are currently under course development and not yet available for enrolments.

The following courses are under development and to be featured units on this degree, but are not yet ready for enrolments and students should plan study according to the units that are currently available: Fine Art 1: 4D Practice (elective), Fine Art 3: Sustaining Your Practice.

If units are numbered, this is the suggested order per level they should be studied. Units labelled (Core) are mandatory and must be undertaken.
