New students are advised to enrol to one unit in the first instance, and this should be the first core unit.

Level 1 (HE4)

120 credits required = 3x 40 credit units

1. Photography 1: Expressing your vision (core)

2. Photography 1: Context and narrative (core)

3. Elective Options (Select one)

- Photography 1: Identity and place
- Moving Image 1: Setting the Scene
- Visual Studies 1: Understanding visual culture

Level 2 (HE5)

120 credits required = 2x 60 credit units

Elective Options (Select two)

- Photography 2: Landscape, place & environment
- Photography 2: Documentary - Fact & Fiction
- Photography 2: Digital Image and Culture
- Photography 2: Self and the Other
- Moving Image 2: Methodologies
(prerequisite Moving Image 1)

Level 3 (HE6)

120 credits required = 3x 40 credit units

- Photography 3: Contextual studies

2. Photography 3: Sustaining your practice (core)
