

Music Degree Pathway



New students are advised to enrol to one unit in the first instance and we recommend to start with the first core unit.

Level 1 (HE4)

120 credits required = 3x 40 credit units

1. Music 1: Composing music (core)

2. Music 1: Stylistic techniques (core)

3. Elective Options (Select one)

- Music 1: From present to past
- Visual Studies 1: Creative arts today

Level 2 (HE5)

120 credits required = 2x 60 credit units

Elective Options (Select two)

Choose two units below recognising that you must have done the relevant course at Level 5 for your Major Project at Level 6.

- Music 2: Moving on with composition
- Music 2: Orchestration and Arrangement
- Music 2: Instruments and Repertoire

Level 3 (HE6)

120 credits required = 3x 40 credit units

1. Units studied concurrently (core)

- Music 3: Major project
- Music 3: Contextual studies

2. Music 3: Sustaining your practice (core)

Level 3 units of the Music Degree are currently under course development and not yet available for enrolments

The following courses are under development and to be featured units on this degree, but are not yet ready for enrolments and students should plan study according to the units that are currently available: Music 2: History and context (elective).

If units are numbered, this is the suggested order per level they should be studied. Units labelled (Core) are mandatory and must be undertaken.
