BA Hons Drawing	<u>Drawing 1.1: Drawing Practices</u> To make the course unit more student centred and easier to complete • Project 1: will be written to re-position practical exercises so that they appear earlier on in the project. • Project 3: research task will be reformatted - text will be introduced via extracts with more scaffolding and guidance on how to approach it.
BA Hons Drawing	<u>Drawing 2.2 Conversations and Contexts</u> To review and reduce workload for two projects where excessive workload has been reported. • Project 5 & Theme 2 - The change will provide more information and context for students around how the tasks can be managed to ensure that they fit into the scheduled time. Exercises will be reduced and/or strategies provided for responding flexibly.
BA Hons Graphic Design	<u>Graphic Design 2.1: Professional Practice</u> • Project 1: Removing a challenging exercise to enable clarity and focus to other exercises in Project 1.
BA Hons Painting	<u>Painting 1.3 Painting in Practice</u> • Project 9 Research Task One - reduce the reading extract required for this task so support completion of task within time allocation
BA Hons Painting	<u>Painting 2.1 Ideas Lab</u> • Theme selection - to change requirement for student to select 3 themes not four to work from • New Themes - to add additional theme options in '<i>Decolonising Thought</i>' and '<i>Care</i>'.
